drawing and art

Art Exploration. Ages 3 and 4; Ages 5 and 6. An introduction to all mediums of art in a fun and creative way.

Drawing. Ages 10 and up. Study of basic principles of construction of visual forms. Emphasis on line, perspective, shading, and portrait study.

kindermusik and instrumental

Kindermusik "Mommy and Me". Ages Newborn–18 mos.; 18 mos.–3 years. We take those special bonding moments between you and your baby and add in a unique blend of musical learning activities that stimulate and engage all of the senses. Your educator will teach you how to encourage your baby's learning through vocal play, object exploration, instruments, and creative movement.

Brasswinds & Woodwinds. Ages 9 and up. This course will teach the student how to produce a good sound on his/her instrument, basic and alternate fingerings, "breathing technique", how to read, count and interpret musical symbols, some basic music theory, ensemble playing, and the history of his/her instrument.

Guitar Class: Ages 9 and up. Students will be introduced to playing basic chords and reading music.

fitness classes

Gentle Yoga. (All levels) A 45 minute fitness-based yoga class designed for beginners to intermediate practice. Relax in this gentle class while incorporating skills such as strength, balance, coordination, flexibility and breathing. No Eastern mysticism. Please bring a yoga mat, comfortable clothes and water.

by fun and free expression, sound Christian beliefs and age-appropriate music, your young dancer will be exposed to the principles of classical ballet and true jazz and tap dance. For this class we ask that the little ladies have white leotards, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, tan jazz shoes and black tap shoes. Our gentlemen will need a white T-shirt, black shorts and black jazz shoes. Hair must be worn off the face, neck and ears.

Ballet/Jazz. Ages 6–10. Ballet class will focus on the basic principles of ballet dance, discipline and in the development of a solid basic knowledge of ballet technique and ballet terminology. These dancers are asked to wear a light pink leotard and pink tights with pink ballet slippers. Gentlemen will need a light blue T-shirt and black shorts or dance pants and black jazz shoes. Hair must be worn in a bun for ballet class. Jazz is the only American born art form and like its music cousin, its roots are fed by the nutrients of the social dances of the day. So, this jazz class may include social jazz like swing and hip-hop, but will primarily focus on a strong development of jazz dance technique and performance. For this class the dancers will be asked to wear their pink leotards with black jazz pants and black jazz shoes. Hair will need to be worn in a bun or ponytail. Gentlemen will need a light blue T-shirt and black shorts or dance pants with black jazz shoes.

Ballet. Ages 11–18. Ballet class will focus on the continuing development of classical ballet training, discipline and terminology. The ladies are asked to wear burgundy leotards and pink tights. They will also need pink ballet slippers. Ballet skirts may also be worn and dance sweaters may become necessary in the winter. Hair must be worn in a bun for ballet classes. Gentlemen will need a navy blue T-shirt and black shorts or dance pants with black jazz shoes.

Hip-Hop. Ages 8 and up. Dancing to a rhythmic beat and contemporary dance step stylings as seen on music videos.

theatre

Musical Theatre. Students will be introduced to the basic concepts of traditional musical theatre, focusing primarily on group singing and dancing. Musicals on which the curriculum will focus include Annie, The Sound of Music, Joseph and the Amazing Techno-Colored Dreamcoat, as well as other age appropriate, family friendly musicals. By the end of the course, the students will know how to sing on pitch as well as perform in fully choreographed group numbers.

Musical Theatre Troupe. This is an auditioned performing group which will be going into the community to showcase their talents.

Acting. Ages 7–18. An acting class designed to introduce your children to the beginning methods of how an actor does what an actor does best, with one-on-one

guidance and training. The focus of the class is to introduce and inspire young, aspiring actors and actresses to the craft in a way that is fun, informative, and out of the box! Special emphasis will be placed on improvisation, getting kids to think outside the box and open up, overcoming stage fright, mime techniques, and other fun-filled activities!

Students will be introduced to basic gymnastics, tumbling, balance beam, and floor exercise.
